ANNUAL STUDENT FEE NOTICE

Students Seeking Admission into B.E./B.Tech (Undergraduate Courses)
for the Academic Year 2026–2027

All prospective students and their parents seeking admission into the B.E./B.Tech undergraduate courses at Chaitanya Bharathi Institute of Technology (CBIT) under Category–B Management(Merit) Quota for the Academic Year 2026–2027 are hereby informed that the annual tuition fee for the block period 2025–2028 has been fixed by the Government at ₹1,83,000/-, vide G.O.Ms. No. 6, Higher Education (TE) Department, dated 04.03.2026.

However, during the proceedings and the hearing before the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (TAFRC), the Committee had calculated and determined the annual student fee as ₹2,23,000/-, which itself is subject to challenge by the institution for upwards revision. Before the issuance of the G.O.Ms. No.6 dated 04.03.2026, the state government had earlier asked the fee of the previous block period to continue for the first year of the 2025-2028 block period (*vide* G.O. Ms. No.26 dated 30.06.2025) after the determination of fee for the institution at ₹2,23,000/-. Based on the orders of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No. 19573 of 2025, dated 09.07.2025 (which writ petition assailed G.O. Ms. No.26 dated 30.06.2025), the Institute was permitted to collect an annual student fee of ₹2,23,000/-, during the pendency of the petition.

The annual student fee for the block period 2025–2028 is presently subject to further proceedings before the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana, and the final fee is subject to upwards revision based on the outcome of such proceedings before the Hon'ble Court and the orders of the competent authority.

Accordingly, all prospective students and their parents are advised to take note of the above while seeking admission into the B.E./B.Tech undergraduate courses at CBIT under Category–B Management (Merit) Quota for the Academic Year 2026–2027.
